

CA ISBU Statement on Windows 7 Support August 26, 2009

CA has been working with Microsoft® to enable our current and upcoming lines of Internet Security solutions to integrate with Windows 7. CA will support Windows 7 upon launch of CA Internet Security Suite 2010 and we are working toward having all of the business products (e.g., Threat Manager, etc.) supported on Windows 7. According to the Microsoft website (<http://www.microsoft.com/windows/windows-7/default.aspx>) Windows 7 will be released to manufacturing (RTM) on October 22, 2009.

CA has utilized its relationship with Microsoft to deliver some of the best anti-malware products available on the market today. Our customers can be confident that our security solutions, that are designed to protect mission critical assets, be it an enterprise network or family photos, will be compatible with Microsoft's latest operating system.

CA is working with Microsoft on a stringent certification of our products to run on Windows 7. While it is available to many channels today, we cannot claim certification on Windows 7 until Microsoft officially launches the product. Once the final build of Windows 7 is RTM, CA will post the official certification of products of Windows 7.

- **CA ISS 2010 (beta)**
- **CA Anti-Virus Plus Anti-Spyware 2010 (beta)**
- **CA PC Tune Up Plus 2010 (beta)**
- **CA PC Tune Up 2010 (beta)**

Current implementations of CA Threat Manager r8.1 require a patch to be installed to make the Windows 7 operating system available as an option to select. Please contact CA Support to receive the patch.
