ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO70484)</p> <p>4.4: ENQ MF DURING ENTIRE UTILITY SCAN PROCESS</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: Utility -SCAN processing issues RESERVE (if converted, converts to SHR ENQ), but then issues DEQ almost immediately afterward. This creates a condition for clients who do not convert the RESERVEs which may cause a deadly embrace.
