The level of the VIEW code should be at least r12.1 and the CA Deliver code should be v12.0 or below.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: The SARBCH bundle reprint fails with a RC=16 and message SARBCB23 Deliver interface function "DLST" not supported is issued.</p> <p>IMPACT: The bundle cannot be reprinted.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: The only circumvention is to use CA View code that is the same level as the CA Deliver code.</p> <p>PRODUCTS AFFECTED: CA View r12.1 CA View r12.2 Star Problem(s): VIEW 1887</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2014 CA. The abend is occurring in the DRAS XENOS transform module CAHADSOX at offset AE8 while looping through the GCR report attributes table. Under certain conditions, the attribute search goes beyond the end of the table resulting in either a S0C4 or S0C1 abend.</p> <p>IMPACT: CA DRAS task needs to be recycled after the abend. Certain AFP reports cannot be viewed using OM Webviewer.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: None</p> <p>PRODUCTS AFFECTED: CA VIEW 12.0 CA VIEW 11.7</p> <p>Star Problem(s): VIEW 1885</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2014 CA. However, if the next backup is an interim backup, retention evaluation is based upon NGEND and NGENT which may result in a pre-mature deletion of the ARCHDATE changed report.</p> <p>IMPACT:            ARCHDATE changed reports may be deleted pre-maturely before being backed up to tape.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:            Issue a SARBCH "/PERM" command to put the report back under ERO control immediately after it has been updated with the "/CHANGE ARCHDATE" command.
