ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO73337)</p> <p>ENHANCE DSI CERTIFICATE HANDLING</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: Currently a user can create a certificate signing request (CSR) using the SI_execute_security_command function. However, the user must employ some method (such as FTP) outside of DSI to access the CSR. Also, while the DSI function SI_dataput allows a certificate to be added to the security product, it also requires that a key ring be created at the same time.
