ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO81301)</p> <p>CMGR OBJECT ACCESS EVENTS MISSING PROGRAM NAME UNDER RACF</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: Compliance Manager object access events under RACF are sometimes missing the program name from the record. Program name in ACF2/TSS versions always shows up. Need to have RACF behavior match ACF2/TSS.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: Program name on object access event records is blank for some events.
