ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO80992)</p> <p>EZYEDIT CLONE,COPY,MOVE FAILED BY SECURITY</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>EZYEDIT CLONE,COPY,MOVE commands will be incorrectly failed by security with the following conditions :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- PDSMAN \$SECURITY rule specifies CLASS=DATASET</li> <li>- CLONE, COPY, or MOVE command has been issued</li> <li>- User has proper security access to the data set</li> <li>- A volume serial was not specified on the EZYEDIT Selection Panel</li> </ul> <p>The problem occurs because EZYEDIT incorrectly determines DUMMY should be used as the data set's volume serial.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>User gets 'Access Denied' message when issuing CLONE, MOVE or COPY.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>This problem only affects the EZYEDIT CLONE, MOVE and COPY commands when the PDSMAN \$SECURITY rule specifies CLASS=DATASET.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>The problem can be circumvented by specifying the data set's actual volume serial on the Selection Panel.</p> <p>PRODUCTS AFFECTED:</p> <p>CA PDSMAN PDS Library Management r7.7</p> <p>Related Problem:</p> <p>PDSM 1028</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2015 CA.
