ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO86854)</p> <p>SKIP DATA ENCRYPTION EDITS FOR UPDVERIFY FOR 15.0</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: When doing a Datadictionary 15.0 upgrade and the upgrade did not complete successfully, the user may potentially receive error messages regarding encryption and recovery which are not necessary when executing the DDSCLM Batch Utility. This only affects the DDSCLM VERIFY function not the DATA-DICT comparator.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: When doing a Datadictionary 15.0 upgrade and the upgrade did not complete successfully, when executing the DDSCLM utility the user might receive error messages such as: DDPDE30001 ENCRYPTION NOT ALLOWED W/O RECOVERY</p> <p>IMPACT: The user receives unnecessary error messages.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: None.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED: CA Datacom Datadictionary Version 15.0</p> <p>Related Problem: DD 2130</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2015 CA. ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO87047)</p> <p>SOC7 IN DBRCVPR AND OTHER DBUTLTY ISSUES</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>After applying PTF RO80114 (14.0) or RO80123 (15.0), a storage overlay can occur while running a CA Datacom/DB DBUTLTY function which invokes SORT. This can occur if DBUTLTY is run in a small region.</p> <p>DBUTLTY functions which may invoke SORT include LOAD, RETIX and RECOVERY OPTION=BACKWARD.</p> <p>A known abend this overlay causes is a SOC7 in module DBRCVPR while running RECOVERY OPTION=BACKWARD.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. DBUTLTY abends with a SOC7 in module DBRCVPR at or around offset x'48EA'. 2. Other unpredictable symptoms can occur due to the storage overlay. <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>The affected DBUTLTY function fails.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>Increasing the DBUTLTY region size may provide a circumvention.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED:</p> <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td style="width: 70%;">CA Datacom/DB</td> <td style="text-align: right;">Version 14.0</td> </tr> <tr> <td>CA Datacom/DB</td> <td style="text-align: right;">Version 15.0</td> </tr> </table> <p>Related Problem:</p> <p>DB 5115</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2015 CA. ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO87088)</p> <p>BATCH 1000 ALTER GETS DDPDCDC003</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>When executing a 1000 ALTER transaction for a KEY occurrence the following message is generated:</p> <p>** ERROR **** RETURN CODE = DDPDCDC003 INTERNAL ERROR - SEE MESSAGE MANUAL</p> <p>This will occur when there is a version of the KEY occurrence in HISTory status.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>Error message is produced when executing a 1000 ALTER transaction against a KEY occurrence.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>The 1000 ALTER transaction can not be used to make the change to the KEY occurrence allowing the change to be implemented in the Multi-User Facility dynamically.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>There are two circumventions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Any HISTory versions of the KEY occurrence can be deleted allowing the 1000 ALTER to function. 2.
