FOR A RECONNECT RESTARTS TOO MANY URTS</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>When a DBEC RESTART=???? command gets initiated on behalf of a connect function on a specific MUF in a Multi-MUF environment, too many URTs get restored to their original status -- even for the MUFs which were not the target of the CONNECT function.</p> <p>The functionality of the command is not changed by this PTF. Only the scope of the command has been changed. The PTF restricts the command to the MUF(s) that failed and have been restarted.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>Some of the URTs which need to stay closed for purposes of taking database backups can be opened up, in error, and be ready to service application requests.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>A backup of the related bases cannot be taken as long as a URT is in open status.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION:</p> <p>None.</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED:</p> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>CA Datacom CICS Services</td> <td>Version 15.0</td> </tr> <tr> <td>CA Datacom CICS Services</td> <td>Version 15.1</td> </tr> </table> <p>Related Problem:</p> <p>DBC 826</p> <p>=====</p> <p>DBOC SHUTDOWN GETS ABEND AEI0, TRANSACTION DBOC FAILS</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>When issuing the command "DBOC SHUTDOWN" to shutdown the CA-Datacom CICS Service Facility, the transaction DBOC ABENDS.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS:</p> <p>The transaction DBOC ABENDS with the following message:</p> <p>DFHAC2206 hh:mm:ss aaaaaaaaa Transaction DBOC failed with abend AEI0. Updates to local recoverable resources backed out. where hh:mm:ss is the time and aaaaaaaaa is the CICS APPL-ID.</p> <p>IMPACT:</p> <p>The impact is minimal. All but one of the shutdown functions are completed by the time ABEND AEI0 occurs.
