ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO96044)</p> <p>HALDB RELOAD DOES NOT REPORT OR VERIFY SEGMENT COUNTS</p> <p>Problem description: A DBO reload should produce an "UNLOAD VERSUS RELOAD" statistics report, showing the difference between the segment counts that were unloaded versus what was reloaded.</p> <p>When unloading a HALDB database, using HDSORT=YES keyword, the report is not generated, and the segment counts are not verified.</p> <p>Symptoms: Reloading a HALDB database using HDSORT=YES keyword does not generate an "UNLOAD VERSUS RELOAD" report, and does not verify the number of segments reloaded.</p> <p>Impact: Possible undetected data loss on reload</p> <p>Circumvention: Omit HDSORT=YES</p> <p>PRODUCT(S) AFFECTED: CA Database Organizer Release 18.0 CA Database Organizer Release 19.0</p> <p>Related Problem: DBO 1099</p> <p>Copyright (C) 2017 CA. ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO96221)</p> <p>IMS APPC CONFIGURATION USES WRONG DEFAULT TPNAME</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION: CA Mainframe Configuration Manager for IMS for z/OS ISPF application has the wrong default TP NAME for IMSID APPC/MVS configuration. Post installation configuration jobs use a different one. This difference causes problem when the default TP NAME is needed.</p> <p>SYMPTOMS: When editing IMS resources for a particular IMS group, CFM can fail on panel CFMEDIT5, because the wrong default TP NAME 'CFMR16_CA_CONFIG_MGR' is used. This TP NAME is not configured on the system.</p> <p>IMPACT: Unable to update IMS resources when Target field specifies particular IMS group name.</p> <p>CIRCUMVENTION: Edit IMS resources while specifying single IMSID in Target field. Then before using Verify and Install functions, update Target field for desired IMS group name.
