ENTRIES = ++PTF (RO95892)</p> <p>UNABLE TO SIGN INTO TPX FOLLOWING COUPLING FACILITY FAILURE</p> <p>PROBLEM DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>User SIGNON is disallowed in a CA TPX Generic Resource environment for one or more of the TPX instances after a System Managed Rebuild recovery of the TPX List Structure into an alternate Coupling Facility (CF) from the sites' Preference List initiated by failure of the original Coupling Facility.
